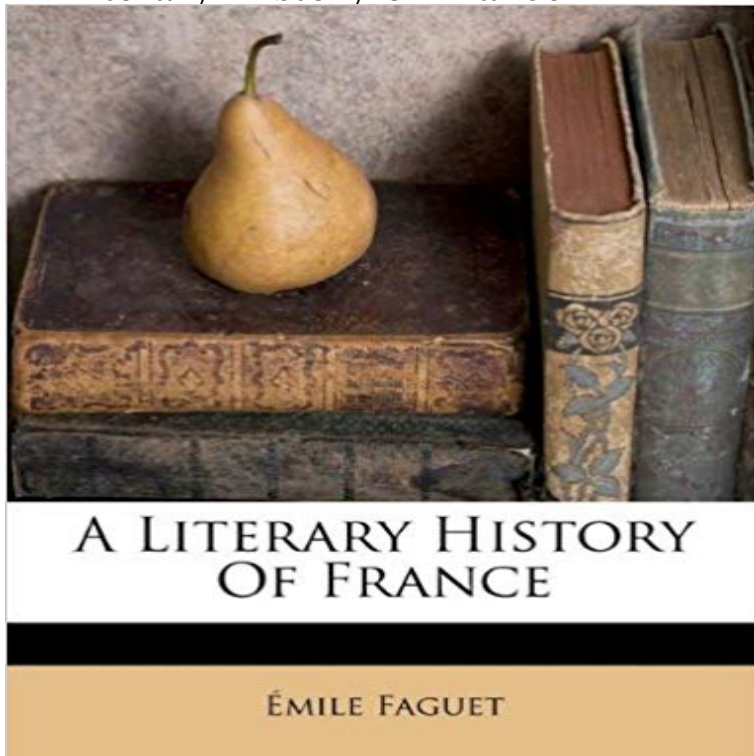


# A Literary History of France
