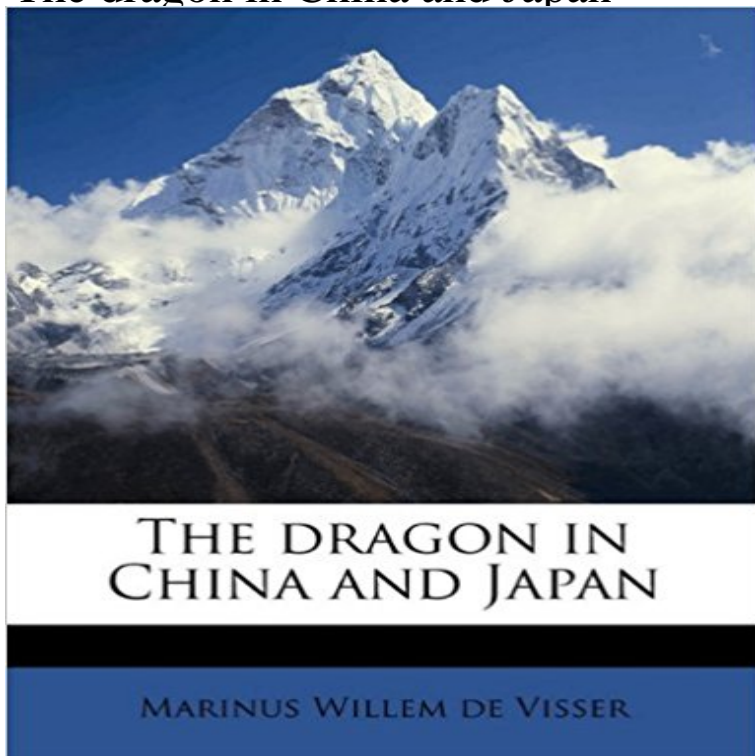


The dragon in China and Japan
