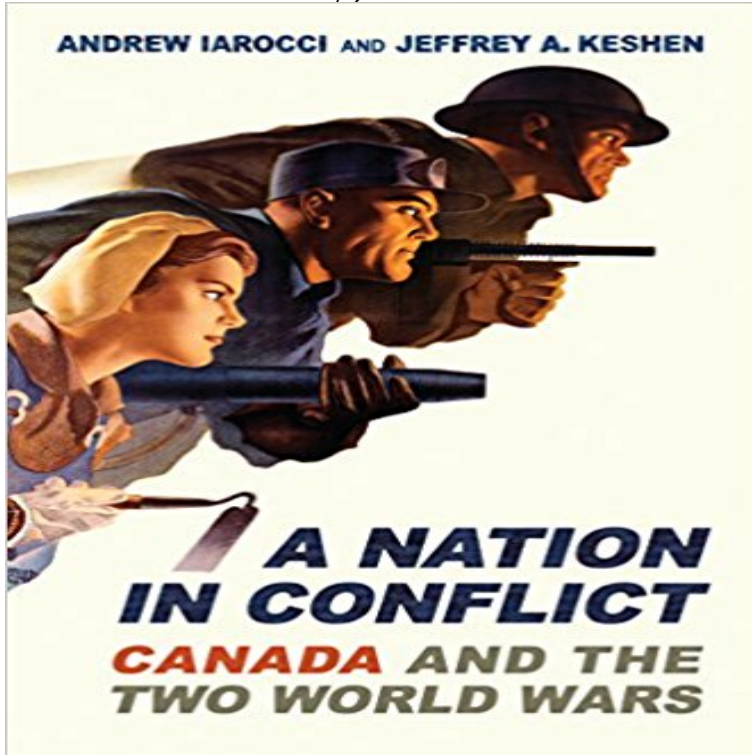


A Nation in Conflict: Canada and the Two World Wars (Themes in Canadian History)
