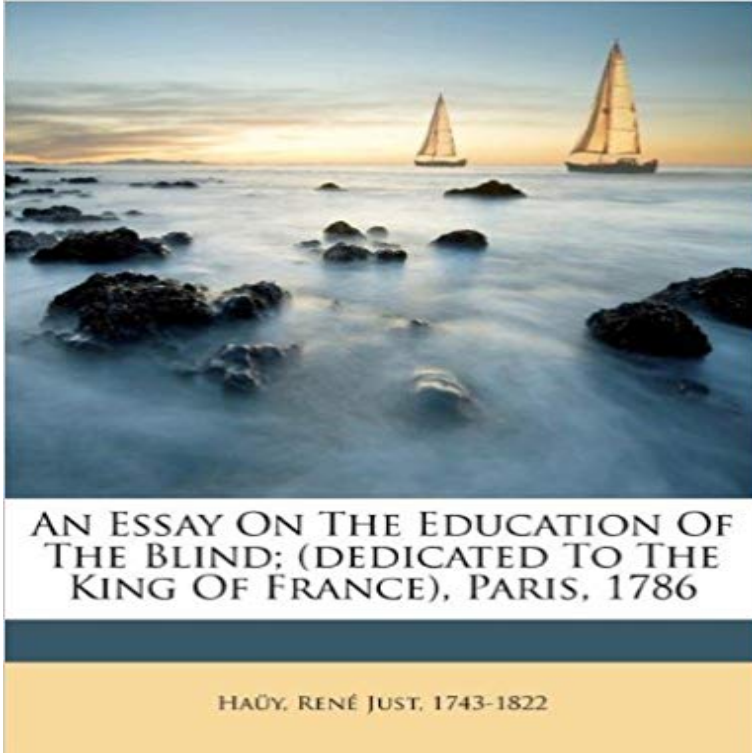


An Essay On The Education Of The Blind; (dedicated To The King Of France), Paris, 1786
