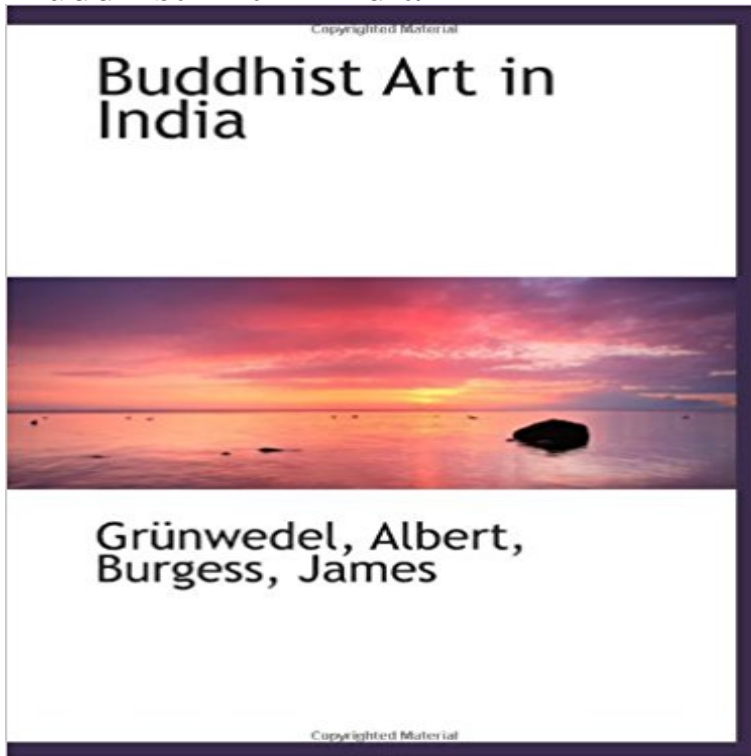


## Buddhist Art in India
