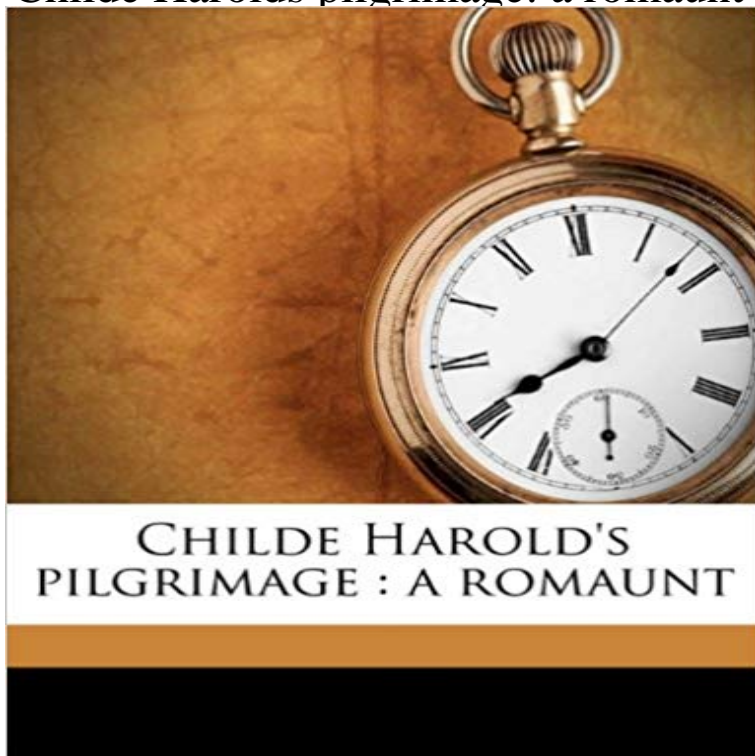


Childe Harolds pilgrimage: a romaunt
