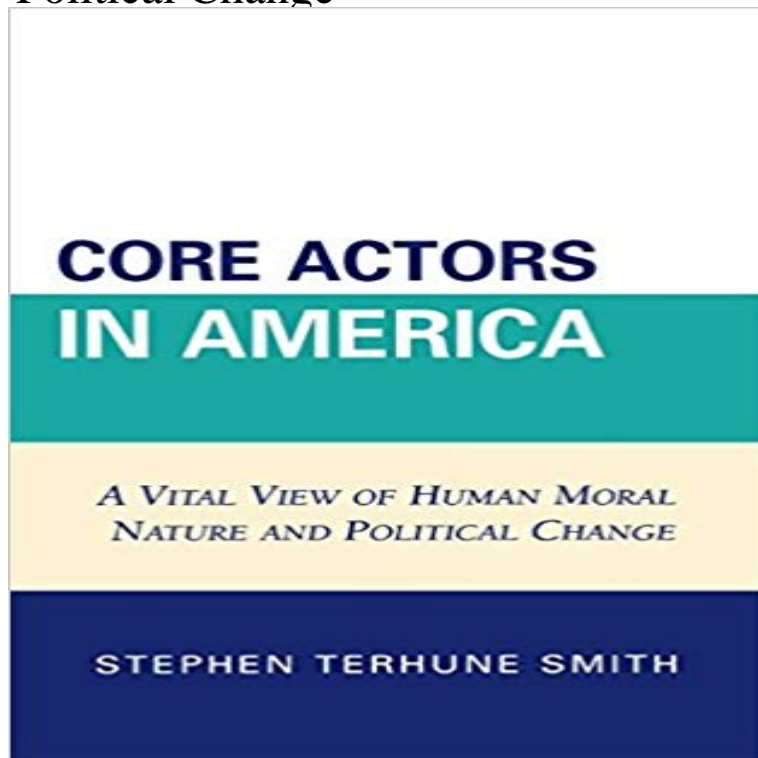


Core Actors in America: A Vital View of Human Moral Nature and Political Change
