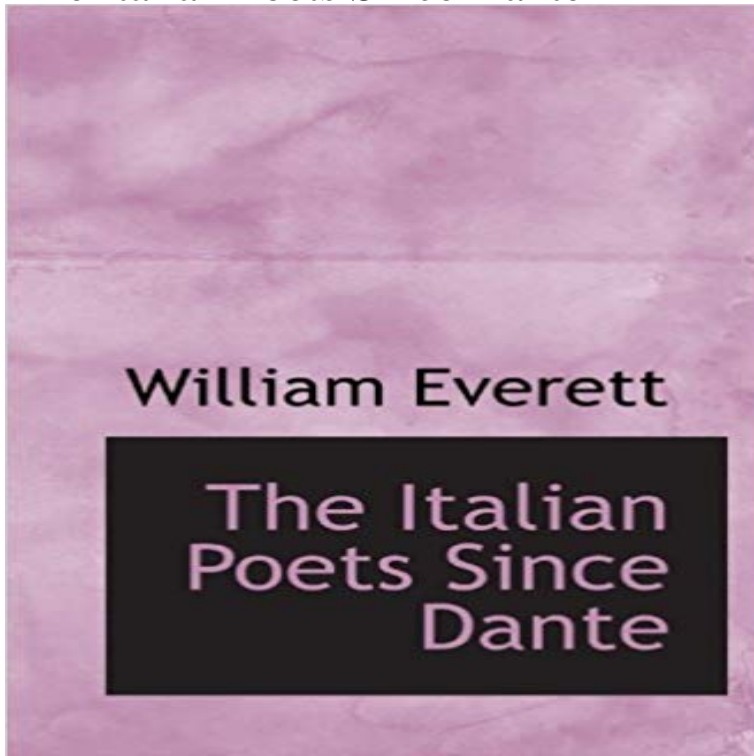


## The Italian Poets Since Dante
