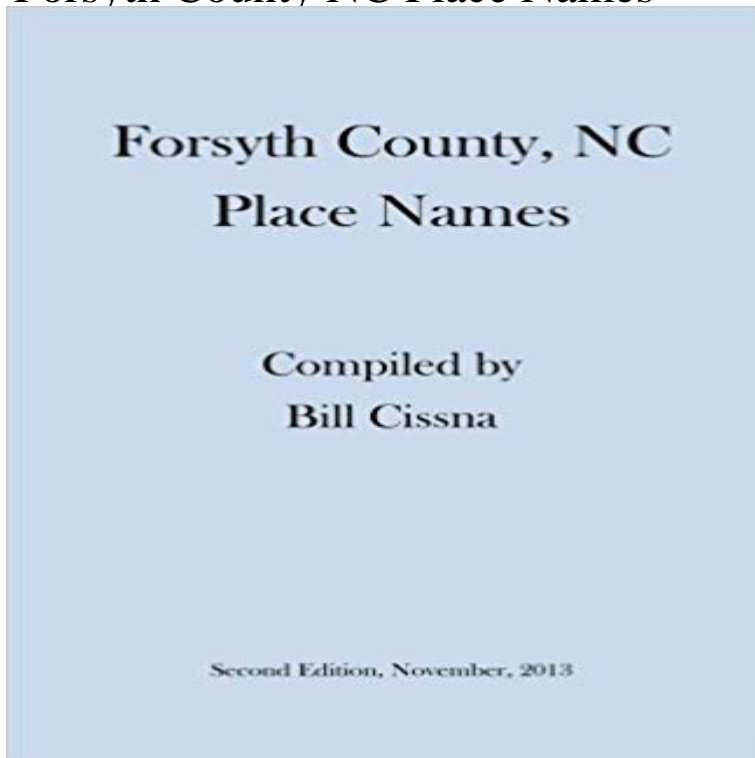


## Forsyth County NC Place Names
