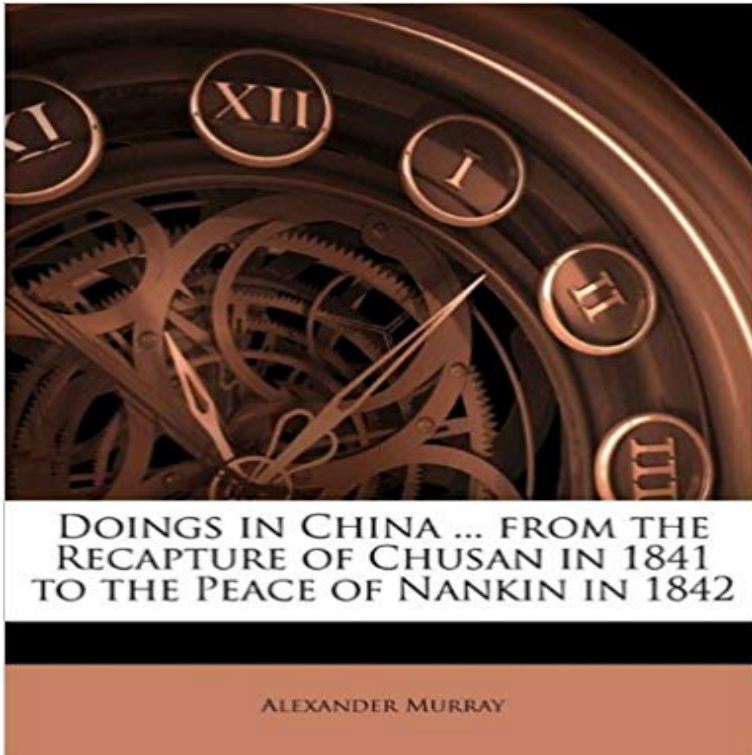


Doings in China ... from the Recapture of Chusan in 1841 to the Peace of Nankin in 1842
