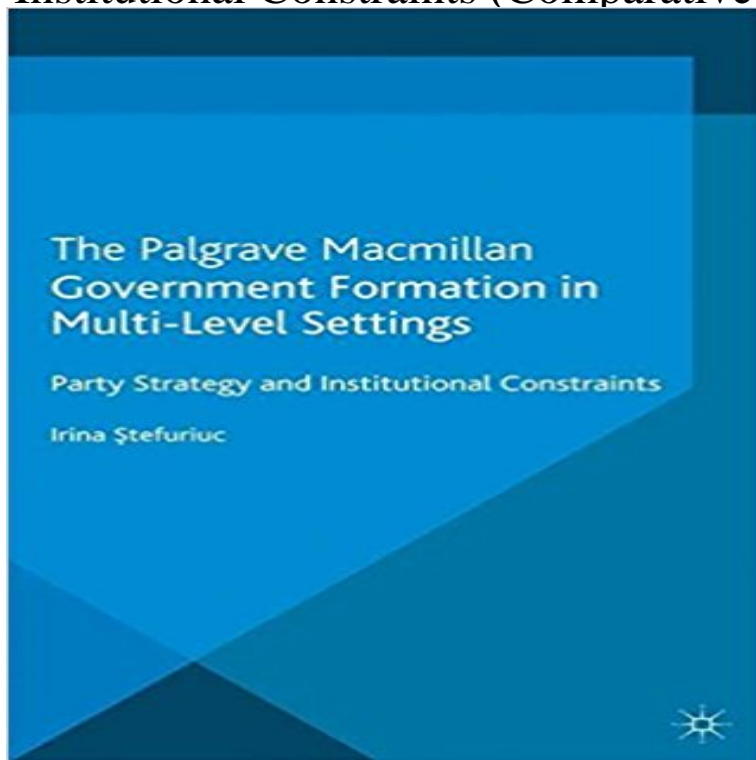


# Government formation in Multi-Level Settings: Party Strategy and Institutional Constraints (Comparative Territorial Politics)
