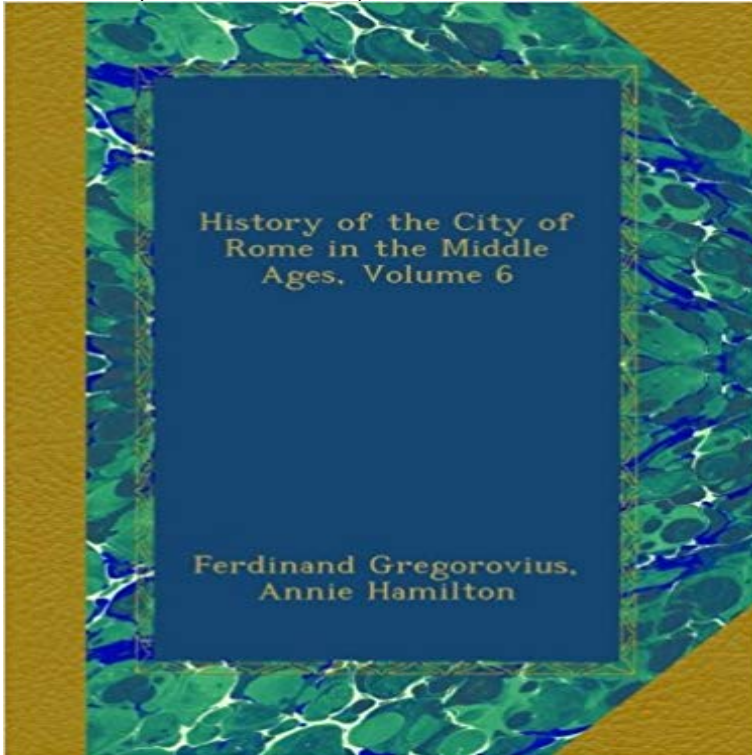


## History of the City of Rome in the Middle Ages, Volume 6
