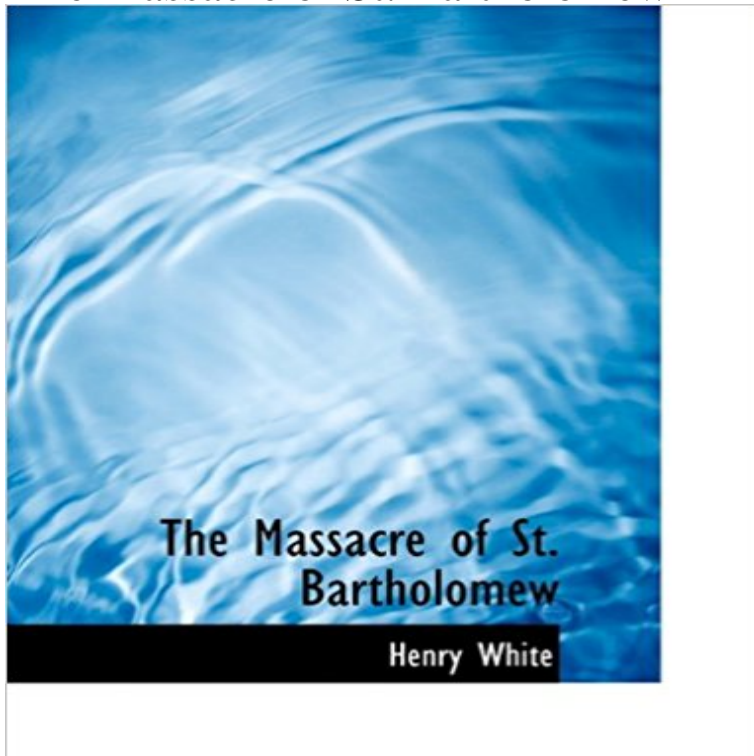


The Massacre of St. Bartholomew
