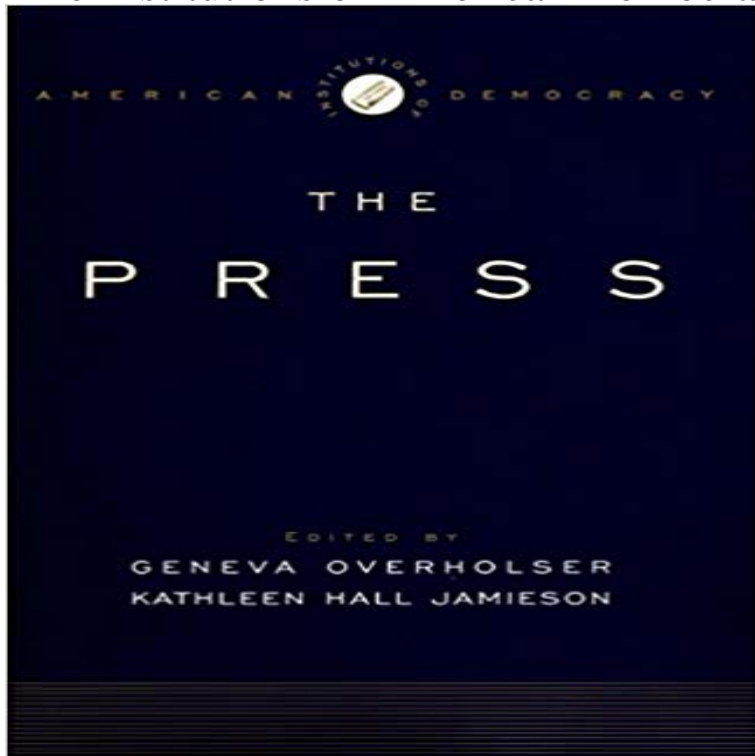


The Institutions of American Democracy
