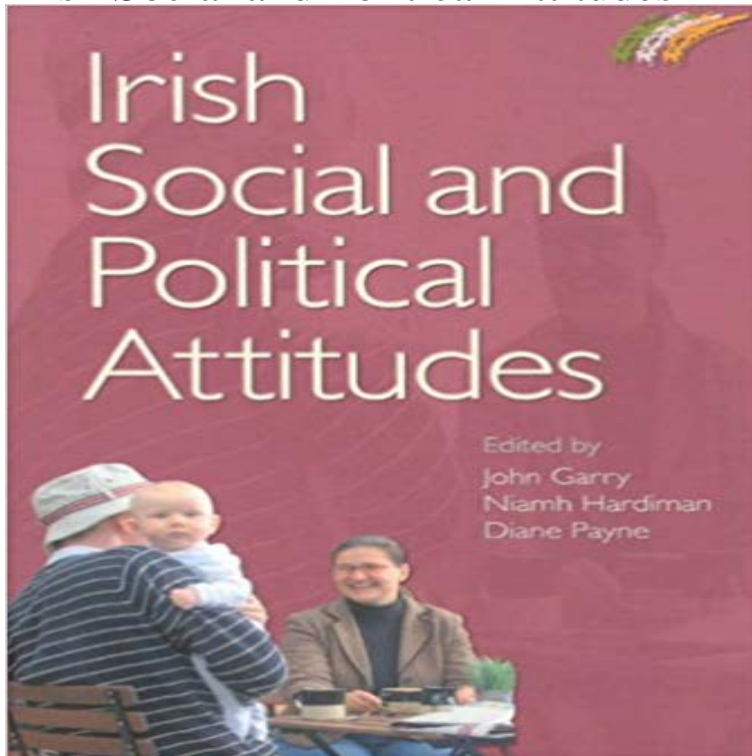


## Irish Social and Political Attitudes
