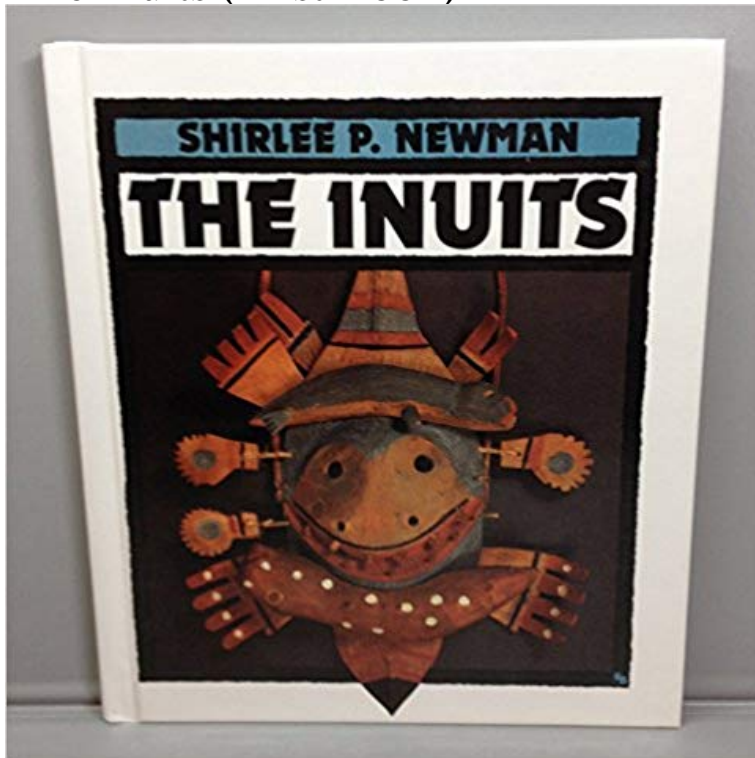


## The Inuits (First Book)
