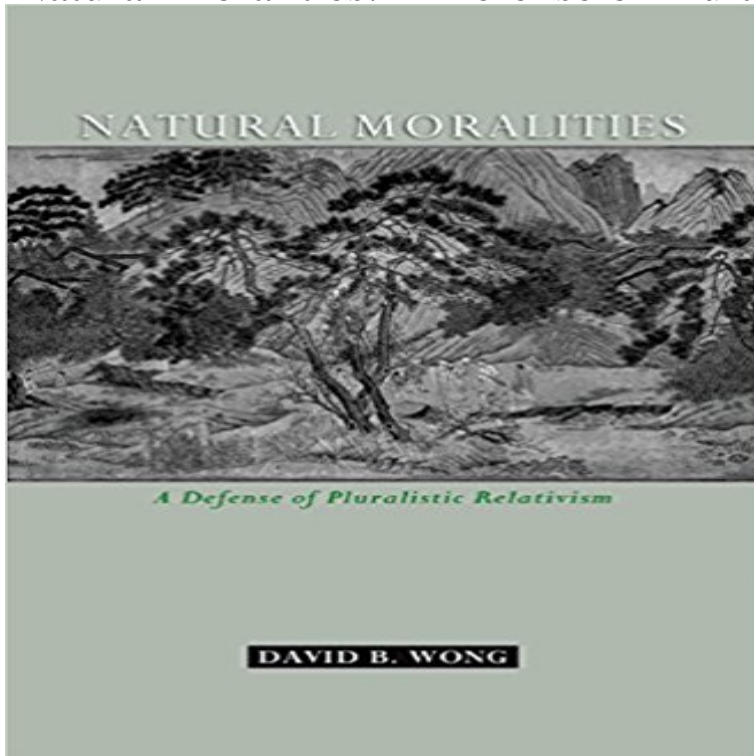


Natural Moralities: A Defense of Pluralistic Relativism
