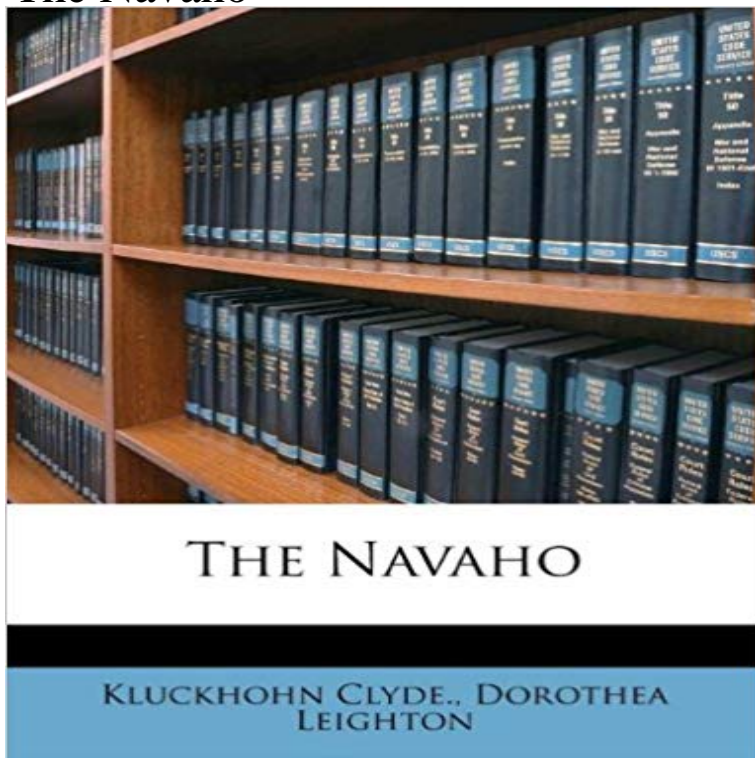


# The Navaho
