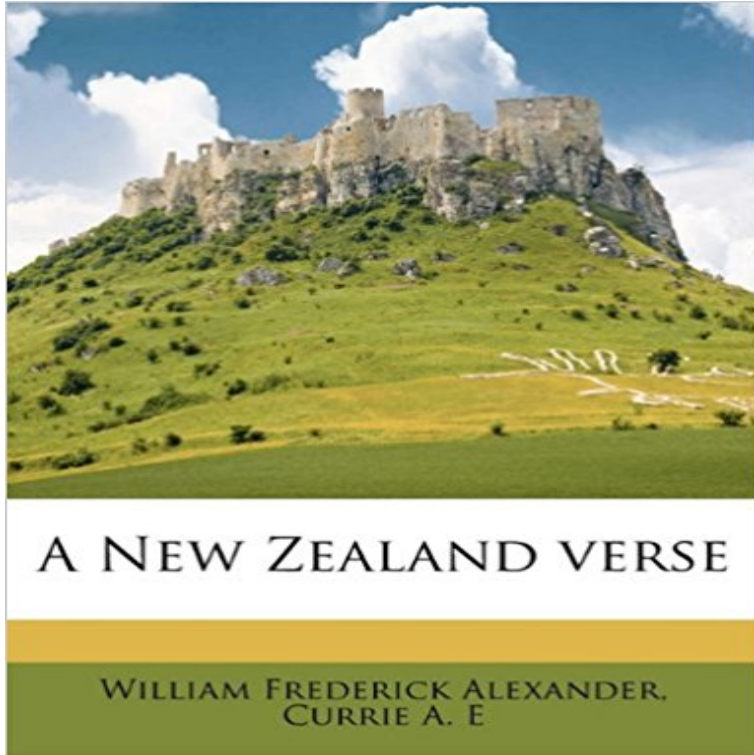


A New Zealand verse
