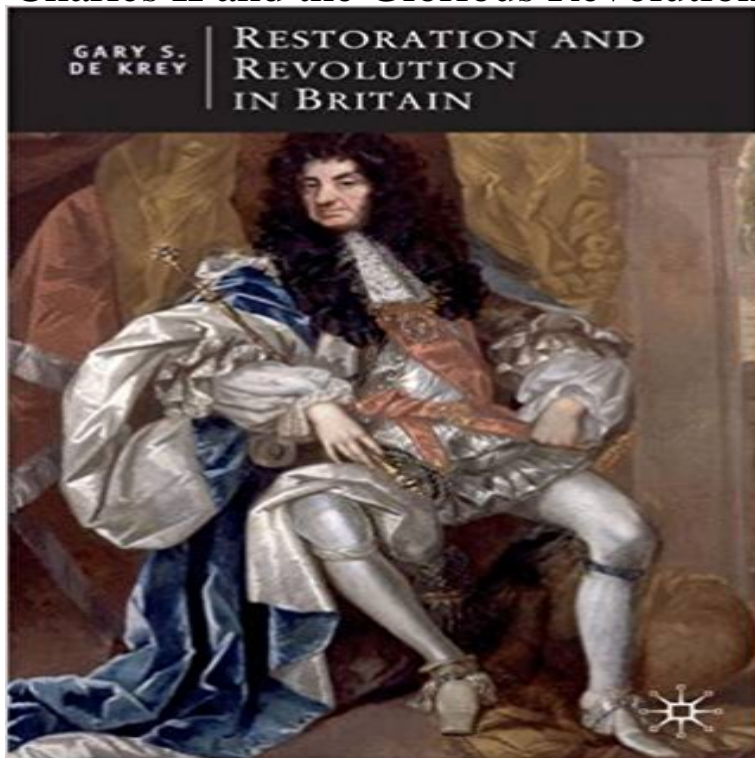


Restoration and Revolution in Britain: Political Culture in the Era of Charles II and the Glorious Revolution (British Studies Series)

The narrative provides essential historical context for studying such figures as Bunyan, Dryden, Locke, and Marvell.
