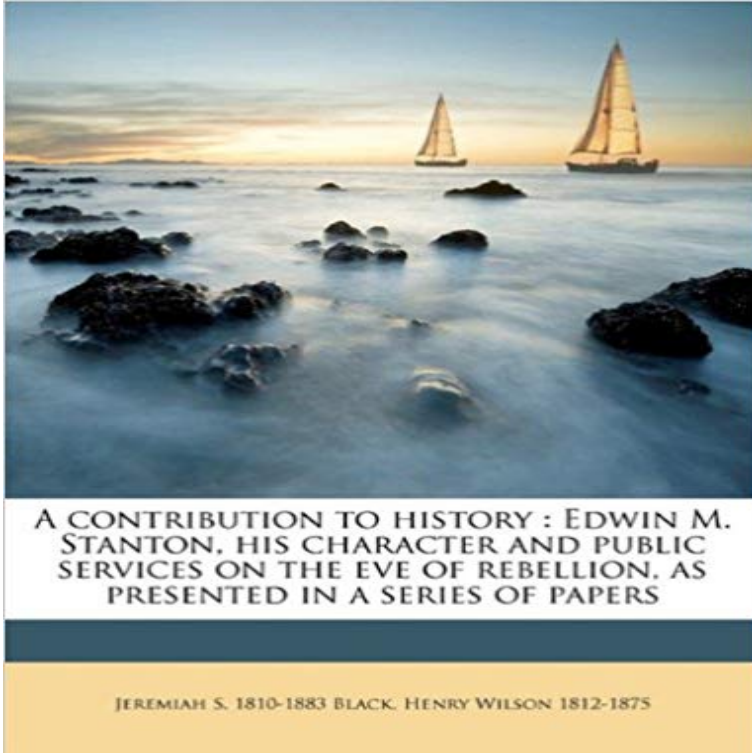


A contribution to history: Edwin M. Stanton, his character and public services on the eve of rebellion, as presented in a series of papers
