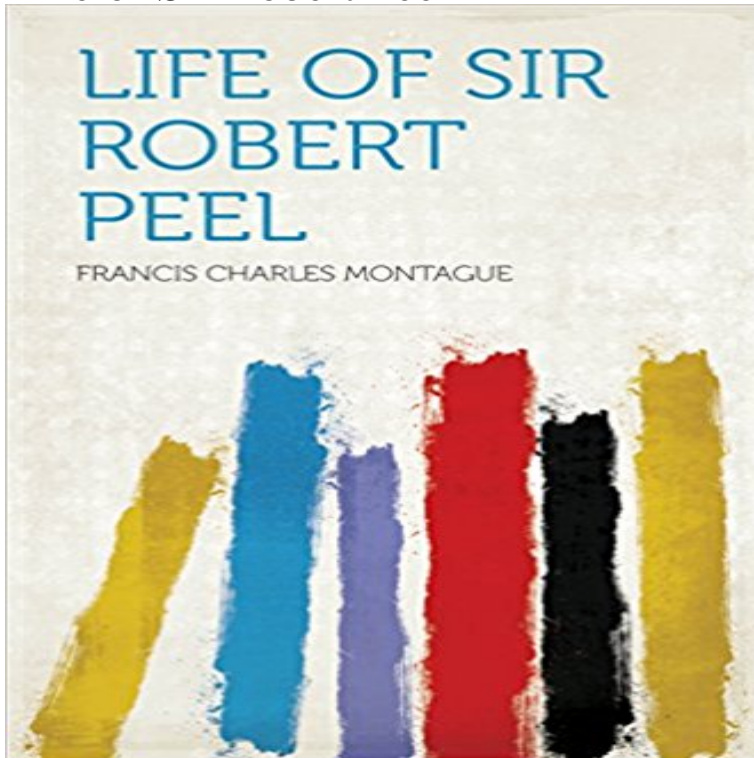


Life of Sir Robert Peel
