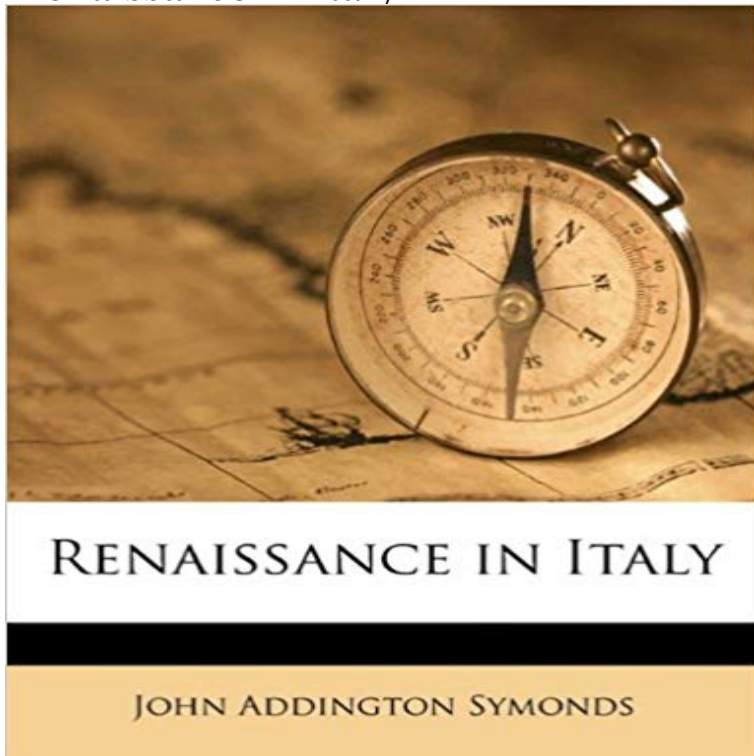


Renaissance in Italy
