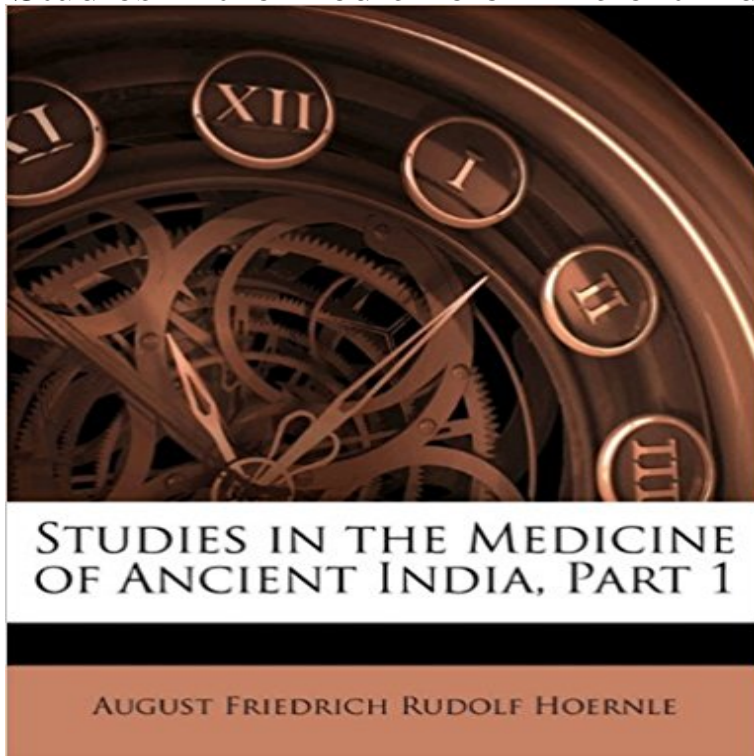


Studies in the Medicine of Ancient India, Part 1
