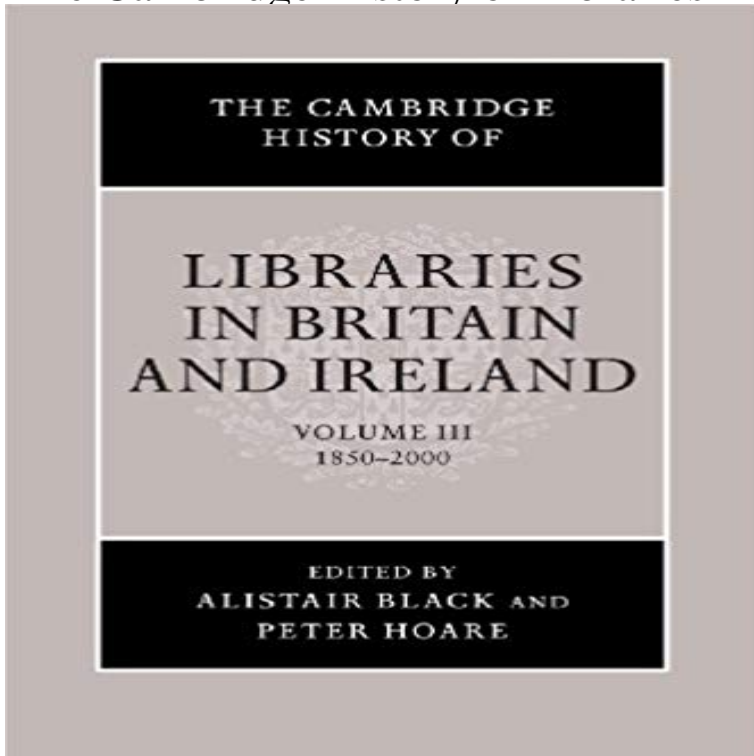


The Cambridge History of Libraries in Britain and Ireland (Volume 3)
