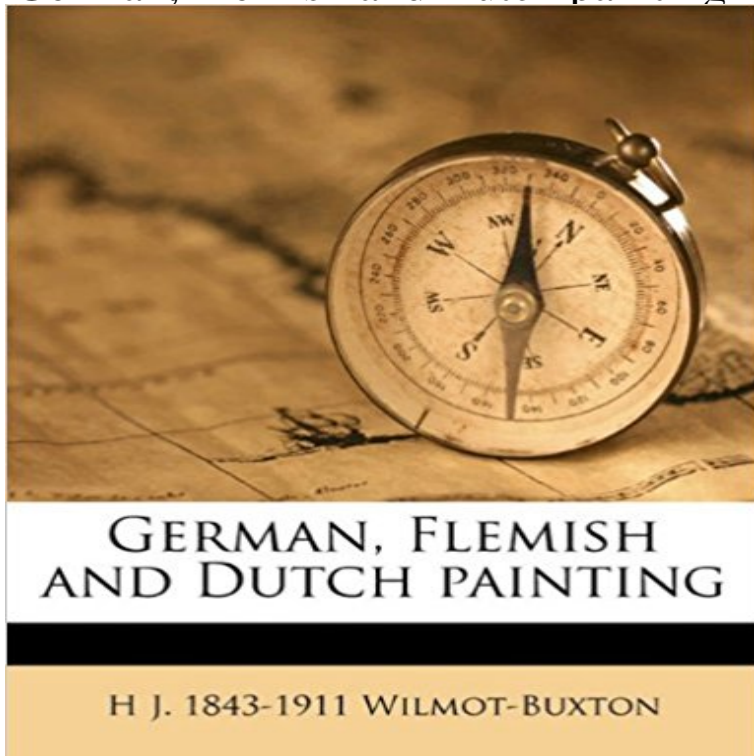


## German, Flemish and Dutch painting
