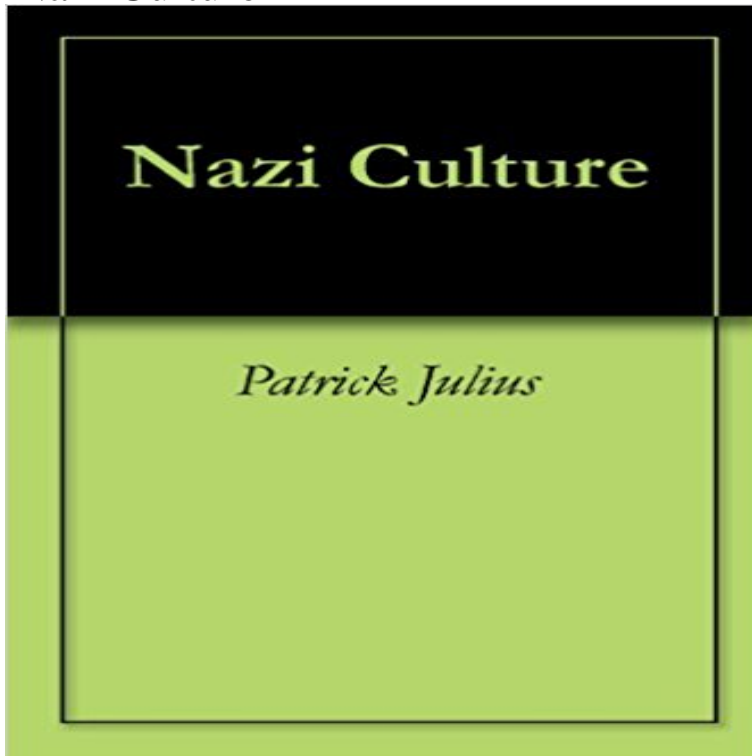


Nazi Culture
