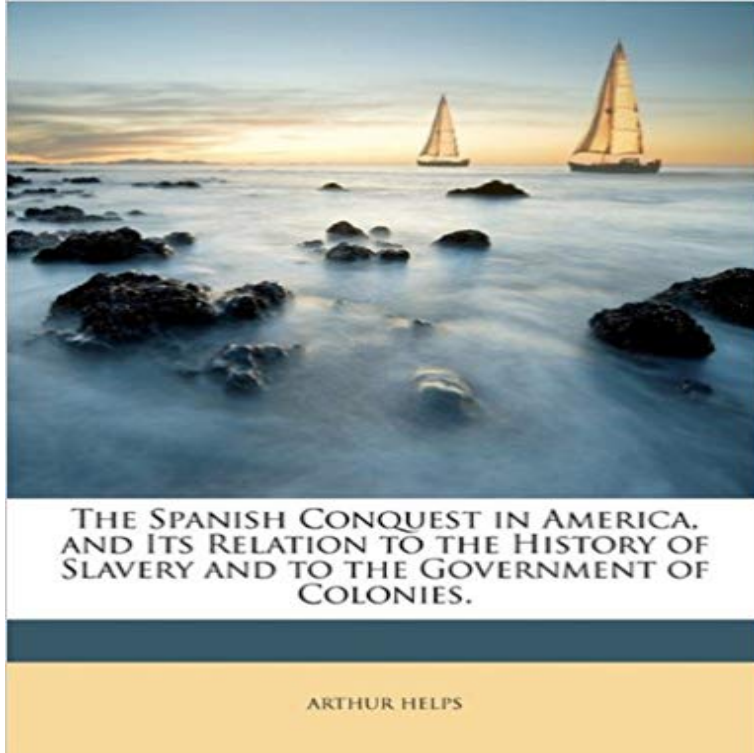


The Spanish Conquest in America, and Its Relation to the History of Slavery and to the Government of Colonies.
