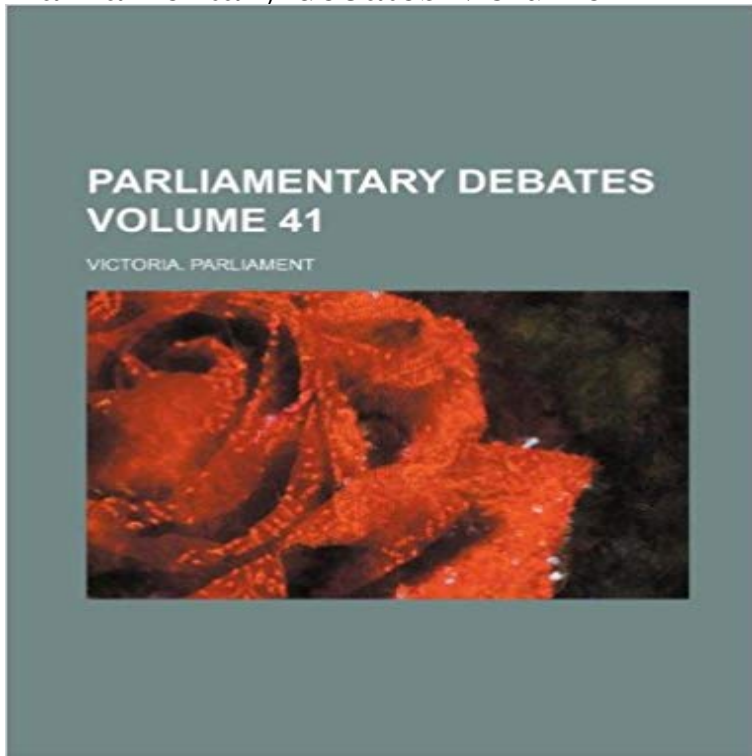

Mr. McKEAN stated that ho was aware of the parliamentary rule, but he wished the House to allow him to propose the motion now. The SPEAKER.--The House cannot do so. The House then went into committee. Sir B. OLOGHLEN moved--That it is expedient that it be an instruction to the committee on the Victorian Loans Redemption Bill to divide the said Bill into two or more Bills. Mr. GRANT seconded the motion. Mr. McKEAN moved that progress be reported. He said his object was to call attention to the motion standing on the notice, paper in his name with reference to certain rules and regulations for the admission of attorneys. The CHAIRMAN.--I will call the honorable members attention to the fact that it is highly irregular to propose a motion for reporting progress with the view to anticipate the discussion of a motion on the noticepaper. Mr. McKEAN remarked that he differed from the Chairmans opinion. Ho (Mr. McKean) had a right to take advantage of the opportunity of expressing his views on the subject of tho motion on the noticepaper. Mr. BERRY submitted that the Chairmans ruling ought to be supported. It was identical with a ruling given by the Speaker the previous evening, when an honorable member desired to move the adjournment of the House in order to discuss a matter on the notice-paper. The same rule that applied to proceedings in the House was applicable to proceedings in committee. Neither on a motion for the adjournment of the House nor on a motion for reporting progress in

committee was it competent for an honorable member to discuss a motion which was set down on the notice-paper for an...
