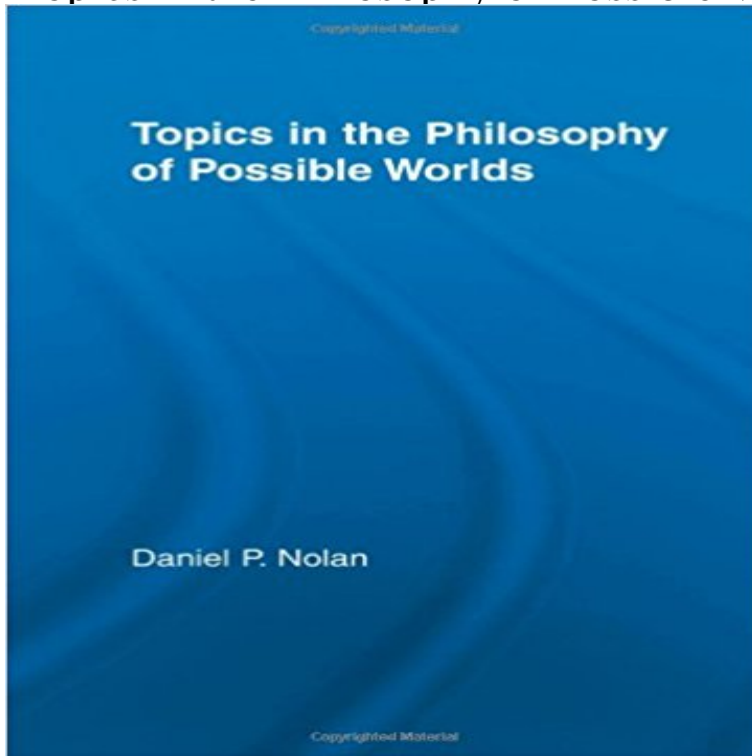


Topics in the Philosophy of Possible Worlds (Studies in Philosophy)
